My name is Randy Hadley and I am the President of the Mid-South Council of the Retail, Wholesale and Department Store Union (RWDSU) here in Birmingham, Alabama. Your organizing committee at BHM1 asked me to reach out to you all to address a few things:

Our union proudly negotiates and services hundreds of union contracts, which workers like you have led the negotiations on in dozens of industries throughout Alabama and the south. Amazon has specifically had much to say about our poultry members that have fought for the last many years and stood together to raise their wages to a new standard for the poultry industry. What Amazon has attempted to do since the day we showed up to support you all in organizing your union is spread misinformation designed to intimidate you and distract you from the real reason you started this fight; to have a seat at the table, job security and protection from being fired for un-just reasons, a good wage with good benefits, and a predictable future. These things are achieved everyday by our members throughout Alabama.

- Let me be clear, our members don't work in a constant state of conflict. Often, they have strong relationships with management. Still, make no mistake when they are treated un-justly, they have a legal, contractual way to address it and protect themselves and they do so as necessary.
- Amazon has insinuated that the union will "pull you out on a strike". Here are the facts, our membership and our membership *ONLY* controls whether or not to strike by a super majority. This means nearly 4,000 Amazon workers would have to vote to go on strike. A strike can be useful when needed, but it is also very, very rare. This is, yet another fear tactic by Amazon.
- Alabama is a right to work state, if you do not want to participate in the union you will not be forced to. Voting for the union and winning a union contract will *NOT* cost you one penny. Being a union member and participating in the union will always be your decision.

In closing, I wanted to share with you personally a true comparison and example of some of the benefits achieved and won by our union members at a warehouse just like the one you work in right here in Birmingham, Alabama.
